New Antech Aerial Catalogue Released

The catalogue covers a wide range of aerials which include, fully automatic, cowl mount, manual retractables, pillar mounts and roof mounts, plus replacement whips & masts.

The handy section in the middle of the catalogue guides technicians as to which of the universal aerials will match vehicles not covered under the OEM section and identifies most vehicles available on New Zealand roads, including used Japanese imports, American cars/SUVS and European models.

To make fitting easier, Antech has developed a range of accessories, such as extension leads, suppressors/filters, plug/socket adaptors, band expanders, mounting ball sockets, mast retaining sleeves, stereo hook-up harnesses, speaker leads etc. These accessories are identified by the vehicle manufacturer they suit and together with specification for hooking up harnesses and speakers.

For those who don't regularly work with antennas and their accessories, Antech has thoughtfully proved an-easy-to-follow guide to installation at the rear of the catalogue.
